- Sherman Avenue to Blue Creek Bay Bridge on I-90 east of Coeur d'Alene, ID.
- Latah Vicinity Paving on SH-8 and US-95 in Moscow, ID.
- Smith Creek to Sheep Creek Phase 2 on US-95, south of Tensed, ID.
